JUDAIC CURRICULUM

Using a dynamic, values based curriculum, ShalomLearning helps students see the connections between their daily life and Jewish tradition and wisdom. Blending classroom instruction and family engagement with technology support, the ShalomLearning approach focuses on seven core Jewish values:

- Teshuvah (תשובה) Taking Responsibility for Our Actions
- B'tzelem Elohim (בצלם אלהים) Honoring the Image of God in Ourselves and Others
- Gevurah (גבורה) Using Strength to Do What's Right
- Achrayut (אחריות) Making the World a Better Place
- Hakarat HaTov (הכרת הטוב) Seeking Joy and Being Grateful
- Koach HaDibbur (כוח הדיבור) The Power of Words
- Shalom (שלום) Contributing to a More Peaceful World

With each grade, the curriculum shifts to deepen the students' understanding.

HEBREW PROGRAM

ShalomLearning has modernized learning Hebrew by providing students a secure portal to practice learning to read Hebrew and *tefillot*. Your child can login from anywhere to complete online activities to practice Hebrew and prayers. Students are able to listen to lines of Hebrew and prayers and record themselves for the teacher to review in between classes.



VIRTUAL CLASSROOM

In a virtual classroom, students see and interact with each other in a real-time, teacher-led class. This type of classroom not only eliminates the need for carpools and fighting traffic, students also understand that learning and Judaism happens everywhere – not just in the traditional classroom.
